## Participate in Aging Research

### AGING STUDY

The aim is to understand how factors, such as gastrointestinal and cerebrovascular function, influence outcomes in healthy individuals and individuals with neurodegenerative conditions. This research aims to assist earlier detection and improve treatments for neurodegenerative conditions.

#### WHAT'S INVOLVED?

Participants may be asked to complete:

- ❖ A confidential interview
- ❖ Questionnaires on mood, feelings, family & personal history
- ❖ Pen and paper cognitive tests
- ❖ Tests of motor function
- ❖ Blood draw, urine and stool collection
- ❖ MRI and fMRI scan
- ❖ Diet following urine and breath test
- ❖ Potential annual participation

Volunteers with the following diagnosis also needed:

- Vascular Cognitive Impairment
- Alzheimer's Disease

Must be between the ages of 50 and 89, and have one of the following:

Parkinson's Disease diagnosis
